Frequently Asked Questions

Do you have to take the prep course?

No, but it is highly recommended. With practice and preparation, you increase your chances of doing well. And, registering for the Prep course does not automatically register you for the ACT exam.

Who should take the ACT exam?

Students who plan to apply to a four-year college or university.

How much does the ACT test cost?

\$33 (plus \$15 for the optional writing test)

Where and when do I sign up?

Get a registration packet in your school's Guidance office or register online at www.actstudent.org.

When can I expect to receive my ACT scores?

Scores are usually sent three to five weeks after the test. Scores are available two weeks after the test at www.actstudent.org.

No. You must register yourself for the ACT.

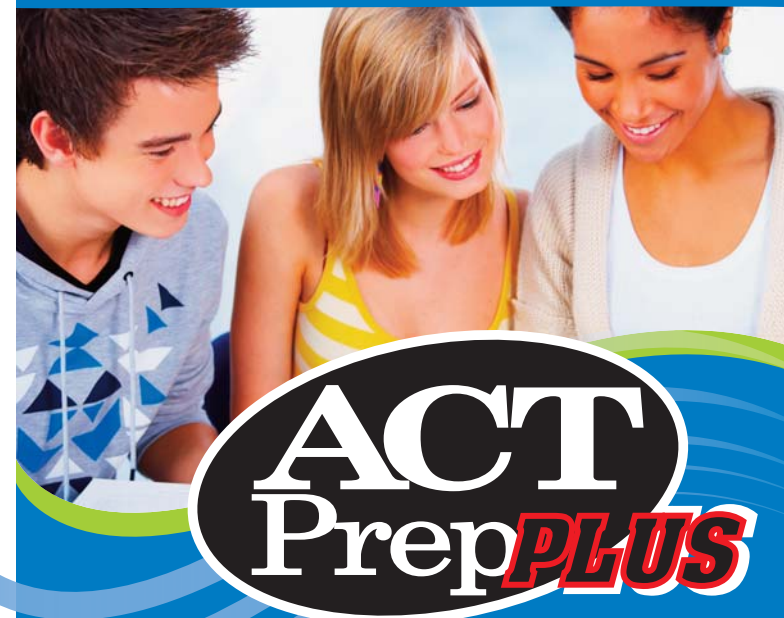

About the ACT Assessment

The ACT Assessment is a standardized college entrance examination that measures knowledge and skills in English, mathematics, reading/writing, and science reasoning as well as the application of these skills to future academic tasks. The ACT consists of four multiple-choice tests:

English	75 questions	45 minutes
Math	60 questions	60 minutes
Reading	40 questions	35 minutes
Science	40 questions	35 minutes
Optional writing test		30 minutes
